Data herein were obtained exclusively from MarketResearchCareers.com from the tenth Annual Survey of Market Research Professionals. The survey was conducted between January 12 and February 1, 2015 obtaining 675 completions from Market Research professionals.

Participants were randomly selected from MarketResearchCareers' membership of more than 50,000 researchers who were invited via email to participate in an online survey. The data have an aggregate tolerance of $+/-3.8 \%$ at the $95 \%$ confidence level.
